Job Duties:

1. Treating patients with various blood, bone marrow disorders and various solid/liquid cancers such as but not limited to breast cancer, colon cancer, prostate cancer, lung cancer, and skin cancer along with bones/joints.
2. Maintain detailed records of patients' health suffering from above disorders.
3. Analyze patient historical data and use data from scans, pathology to make informed decisions.
4. Perform bone marrow biopsies and aspiration procedures to diagnose bone marrow problems relating to blood disorders. This includes interpreting bone marrow reports and making accurate diagnostic interpretations of clinical scenarios.
5. Diagnose and treat blood disorders involving anomalies of the blood cells, the bone marrow, and other organs that are engaged in the synthesis of blood.
6. Conduct wide-range clinical trial research towards the diagnostics and treatment of solid cancers, leukemias, and lymphomas.
7. Prescribe medications, blood transfusions, and Iron infusions for blood disorders. This will include the treatment of blood-clotting disorders with blood thinners and similar medications.
8. Identify and stage various cancers such as lung cancer, breast cancer, colon cancer, stomach cancer, prostate cancer and various other solid cancers via biopsy and scans.
9. Order and interpret various CT scans, MRI scans and PET scans.
10. Treat cancers with chemotherapy, immunotherapy, targeted therapy and monitoring cancer treatment response with various scans. This includes administering chemotherapy for the treatment of lymphoma or leukemia or other blood cancers.
